# **External Scholarships**

### Objective

To encourage boys and girls, at Year 5 and above, to attend Carncot Independent School subject to the availability of places, a Scholarship may be awarded to an external applicant who displays excellence in academic, musical, sporting and/or cultural fields.

### Policy

- 1. An external scholarship shall be awarded to an incoming pupil for the duration of their schooling at Carncot Independent School, subject to the maintenance of appropriate standards of attainment and behaviour.
- 2. The value of a scholarship is a proportion of the annual tuition fee. Incidental costs (such as uniform, school camp fees, sporting fees) are not covered by the scholarship.
- 3. Two scholarships, externally funded, are offered from time to time
- 4. Additionally, there shall be up to three full-time equivalent scholarships awarded in any one year. These may be split (for example, 6 x 50% scholarships, 2 x 100% and 3 x 33% scholarships) at the Principal's discretion.
- 5. Scholarships are available to New Zealand residents only.
- 6. Scholarships shall only be awarded where the current attainments and results achieved by applicants is of a sufficiently high standard, as determined by the Principal.

### Procedures

- 1. A full application is completed, detailing current achievement levels, and providing supporting material and referee contact details.
- 2. Scholarships are awarded after academic examinations, musical auditions and/or Principal's Interview.
- 3. Scholarships usually commence from the beginning of the following academic year.
- 4. Applications for 2023 scholarship entry close on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> September, 22. Early applications are encouraged and welcomed.

# The Carncot Cultural Scholarship

For a child of Māori or Pasifika ethnicity with exceptional potential in family who would otherwise be unable to send their children to Carnot School

This valuable scholarship is offered for the first time, through the generosity of a current family who have seen the impact that Carncot has already made for their own children. Applications are now open for a boy or girl to enter Year 6 or Year 7 in 2024. The value of this scholarship is 75% of the tuition fee, for three (or two) years. Additional financial assistance may be provided by the school to facilitate enrolment if it is shown to be necessary.

# General Excellence Entering Year 5, 6 or 7

The Carncot Trust Board offers External Scholarships to students not currently at the School and entering Year 5, 6 or 7 who display excellence in academic, musical, sporting and/or cultural fields.

Students will be required to attend an interview with the Principal. An academic examination may be required. The value of these scholarships is a proportion of the annual tuition fee for two to four years (depending on year entry level). Please refer to the general scholarship policy for more information.
